

Dear Visitors,

Welcome to the world of motorhome travel. Before you step inside, please take the time to familiarize yourself with our visitor regulations.

- § Our visitor regulations ensure that your visit to the exhibition is a pleasant experience. Complying with the visitor regulations is therefore in your own interest.
- § All visitors must comply with our visitor regulations. On entering the building, you accept that they are binding.
- § Consumption of food and beverages as well as smoking is not allowed outside of the designated areas, which are clearly signposted.
- § Animals are not allowed inside the exhibition building.
- § To prevent accidents and damages, anyone in charge of minors is legally obliged to supervise them.
- § Restrictions are in place with regard to the size of the objects you may take with you into the exhibition building. Coats and jackets can be left in the cloakroom or in the lockers available for this purpose. However, the Museum does not accept liability for loss or damage to any items left there.
- § Mobility aids (e.g. walking frames) may be taken into the building; the same applies to walking sticks, provided they are rubber-tipped.
- § Skateboards, inline skates, city scooters etc. are not allowed inside.
- § You are generally allowed to take photographs for private purposes with handheld cameras that do not require a stand. If you wish to take photographs for commercial or research purposes or news reports (press), you must first obtain the Erwin Hymer Museum's permission to do so.
- § Please note that flying drones is not permitted above the entire Museum grounds, including the Museum car park.
- § You may use your cell phone inside the Museum only in emergency situations.
- § For safety reasons, stairs, doorways and the signposted escape routes must be kept clear at all times.
- § Visitors must take care to ensure that the exhibits are not damaged in any way.
- § A closed circuit television system is in operation throughout the Museum and the grounds.
  
- § You must follow all instructions issued by our visitor services staff. Our Museum staff are authorised to escort visitors that do not comply with the visitor regulations or their instructions from the premises. The admission charge will not be returned to such visitors.
